


Sayyid Al-Hakeem Discusses Political Developments, Iraq's Economic Challenges with EU Ambassador



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met in H.E. office in Baghdad on Monday evening, 26 January 2026, the Ambassador of the European Union Mission to Iraq, H.E. Mr. Clemens Smetaner.
